March 2024 NEDA Report

NEDA news report for Sea Strokes is the first report of this year as we changed the meeting schedules and so our timing is a bit different.

New England Decorative Artist presents, New England Traditions Convention, on October 8th through the 13th 2024. It will be held, again, at the Best Western Royal Plaza Hotel, in Marlborough Mass.

Hotel Rates will be 129 dollars plus tax and sale service fees. It is strongly suggested that you book early as our room block booked up very quickly last year. Please remember when you book, it is best to call this number 508 460 0780 and request the NEDA/ NET room rate vs registering on online. Please call during the week not the weekends as they are less busy, and it will be easier for you.

We are getting excited as the NET Catalog will be available online to download by April 1st, 2024, and you can register, online only, by April 27 th, at 8am. The catalog can be purchased through Amazon too. As always, if you have any questions you can refer to www.newenglandtraditions.org

AFTERNOON PROGRAM

Butterfly Kisses

Design by Tracy Moreau taught with permission by Bonnie Rand

Surface: 10-12" Round, Square, or Rectangular Paper Mache Box

Misc: .38 Gel Pen, Polka Dot Stencil, white graphite paper

Brushes: Stencil Brush, Angles, Ione liner

| Palette: | Antique Green | Asphaltum | Bahama Blue |
|----------|------------------------------|-----------------------------|-------------------------|
| | Cobblestone | Margarita | Orange Flame |
| | Plantation Pine Sunny Day | Prussian Blue Warm White | Saffron Yellow Black |

Prep: On the palette: Prussian Blue, Cobblestone, Asphaltum, Warm White

Basecoat the surface with two coats of Prussian Blue. Let it dry and lightly sand the surface. Stencil the surface with the Polka Dot Stencil and Cobblestone. Let them dry then sand the surface lightly to wear through the pattern a little. It should leave the dots a little distressed and a little worn. Wipe off the dust. Apply a thin wash of Asphaltum to the entire surface. Let it dry then float around the edge with Asphaltum, keeping the darkest value to the outside edge. Let dry. Trace and transfer the line drawing to the surface. Base all elements of the line drawing except the center of the sunflower, with a coat of thinned Warm White.
